Newark recruits its first patient into RIGHT!



Trevor Robinson has recruited the first patient from Newark ambulance station into the RIGHT trial on 3rd May 2011! With this the total number of actively recruiting stations now goes up to eight.



Stroke onset should be less than 4 hours for randomisation.

The exact time of stroke onset may be clear for some patients but less so for others. It is important to include only those patients where the onset of stroke is certain and is less than four hours of onset. If someone wakes up with symptoms, the time of going to bed the previous day should be taken as the onset time. Most such patients will be excluded from RIGHT
